Read: Psalm 27: 1-5

King David wrote these verses in the Bible when he had lots of reasons to be afraid. He knew that God had called him to be the king of the people of Israel, but their old king named Saul did not want to give up the throne. Saul had many soldiers in his army that were chasing David all around the countryside trying to kill him and stop him from becoming king. He had to hide in the hills and sleep in caves to get away from his enemies. Wouldn't that be scary?



But king David was not afraid because he knew that the Lord would take care of him. He believed that God would protect him even if a war broke out against him. King David understood that God is more powerful than any person, or army, or any other scary thing.

Life Application: You believe in the very same God that king David believed in, so you should not be frightened, either. God can take care of you no matter what scary thing might be happening in your life. You really have no reason to be afraid.

Prayer: Dear Lord, Help me to remember that You are stronger than anything that scares me. Remind me to pray to You when I am afraid, and to trust in Your strength. Amen
